From I-275 take Exit 65 Beechmont/Route 125. Travel east on Route 125 through the village of Amelia. Turn right on Lindale Mt. Holly Road. You will make a 90° turn to the left and a 90° degree turn to the right. We are the next drive on the left.

Camp Rules

1. Campers agree to abide by the rules for dress code and items they bring to camp.
2. Campers agree to abide by the camp schedule or they will be dismissed.
3. Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated. Campers are expected to treat others in a Christian manner and respect the authority of WLCC staff, deans, and faculty. A failure to do so will result in dismissal.
4. Campers who destroy camp property, buildings, equipment, grounds, etc. will be responsible for the cost of repair or replacements.
5. Campers caught stealing or pilfering through others belongings will be sent home.
6. WLCC has a zero tolerance policy for anyone possessing weapons, alcohol, tobacco or who ingest or inhale any substance that is harmful and intended to induce a "high". These actions, will result in immediate dismissal.

Health Checks

For the safety of you child, we will be performing a temperature and lice check during Check-in to prevent their camp experience from being cut short due to illness.

What to Bring to Camp

All clothing should be labeled. It's very casual, however no 2 piece bathing suits, short shorts, slit shorts, Speedo's, see through tops, spaghetti straps, bare midriffs, or pants worn that show undergarments!

KEEP LUGGAGE TO A MAXIMUM OF TWO BAGS! We suggest a plastic bag for dirty laundry. *Please remember to check lost and found before you leave.*

Toiletries/Bedding

You are responsible for bringing towels, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, etc. You will want to bring a sleeping bag or sheets and a blanket. Don't forget your pillow!

If you have medications, they **MUST** be in their original containers and you will need to meet with the First Aid Personnel when you arrive at camp.

NO WAY ITEMS

All personal electronics, CD/MP3 players, cell phones, skate boards, inappropriate reading material, trading cards, video games, alcohol, tobacco products, comic books and fireworks. Anything else that will distract from focusing on God and all He has to bring you during your stay at camp should be left at home.

How to communicate with your camper...

Campers love mail! Send to address above with the camp and camper's name on it.

Visitors are discouraged. If you come to camp you **MUST** check in with the office or the First Aid Personnel upon arrival. Please remember that your child will not have access to a cell phone to call or text.

Bring enough clothes for each day, bathing suit, and a jacket in case it's rainy or cold. Please use discretion in selecting clothes that advertise certain products. Decent and modest clothing is required at all times. Bring 2 pairs of shoes. One pair, NOT flip flops for outdoor activities.

FOOTWEAR MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES, THIS INCLUDES FLIP FLOPS OR SANDELS AROUND THE POOL AND IN THE SHOWERS.

Bring your Bible, a notebook, pen/pencil, flashlight, insect repellent, and sunscreen.

BRING YOUR OWN WATER BOTTLE WITH YOUR NAME ON IT. (WE PROVIDE THE COLD WATER, BUT YOU NEED TO PROVIDE YOUR OWN WATER BOTTLE FOR USE DURING THE WEEK.)
