### **Camp Rules**

- 1. Campers agree to abide by the rules for dress code and items they bring to camp.
- 2. Campers agree to abide by the camp schedule or they will be dismissed.
- 3. Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated. Campers are expected to treat others in a Christian manner and respect the authority of WLCC staff, deans, and faculty. A failure to do so will result in dismissal.
- 4. Campers who destroy camp property, buildings, equipment, grounds, etc. will be responsible for the cost of repair or replacements.
- 5. Campers caught stealing or pilfering through others belongings will be sent home.
- 6. WLCC has a zero tolerance policy for anyone possessing weapons, alcohol, tobacco or who ingest or inhale any substance that is harmful and intended to induce a "high". These actions, will result in immediate dismissal.

#### What NOT to Bring to Camp
